JUNEAU USBC CITY CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT TOURNAMENT RULES

1. The schedule will close 10:00 p.m. March 24, 2017. Entries close at the final squad of the tournament. Entry fee must accompany each entry. Only Juneau USBC members are eligible and must be 19 years of age or have a parental consent form filled out before bowling.
2. The tournament is an open format. Teams and Doubles can be men/men, woman/woman, or mixed.
3. The tournament will be divided into two divisions with Division 1 designated for bowlers with averages of 165 and higher. All others will bowl Division 2.
4. Handicap will be computed at 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 230.
5. Unlimited entries are permitted under the following provisions:
 - a. No more than two players on one team can place more than once on the prize list for position standings.
 - b. No doubles pair can place more than once in the prize list for position standings.
 - c. Each individual can only place once in the prize list for position standing.
 - d. If bowling more than once in each event, the first appearance in each event will be used for all-events.
6. Entry fee is \$28 per event, \$5 for the optional all-events, and \$5 for the optional scratch special features. All entry fees must be paid for in advance prior to bowling, including all-events and optional scratch special features. The all-events fee is a 1 time fee, but the scratch fee must be paid for each event bowled.
7. No entry money will be returned after being received by the tournament director.
8. Any member who falsifies their average or furnishes incomplete information will forfeit all prizes and/or prize money and all scores bowled will be disqualified.
9. The team captain must verify check-in thirty minutes prior to squad times for team events and 15 minutes prior for singles/doubles.
10. Anyone entering doubles must enter singles and vice-versa.
11. Team event will be bowled on one pair of lanes. Teams shall consist of four (4) bowlers. Singles and doubles will be bowled jointly, moving lanes between events as directed by the tournament director. Singles will be bowled first. If the squad does not consist of 10 full lanes, the singles lanes will be assigned at the discretion of the tournament committee. An entrant shall be permitted to bowl games in the doubles event without a doubles partner to qualify for the all-event championship. The singles and doubles event will have no more than two bowlers per lane.
12. An entrant who arrives late will forfeit shadow balls and will take "0" pins for each frame missed.
13. There will be at least one prize for every seven (7) entries in the team/doubles/singles events. All-events will be paid at least 1 in 10 entries. The scratch special features will be paid ½ to the high scratch game and ½ to the high scratch series. An individual can place only once, with series taking precedence over game.
14. In case of ties, prizes will be combined and divided by number of ties. Co-champions will be declared in the event of a first-place tie.
15. Entries received without squad times filled in will be scheduled last. There will be no schedule changes except for an emergency.
16. There will be 72 hours to make a written protest after score sheets are signed.
17. Rules 319c, 319d and 319e of the USBC Certified Tournament Rules do not apply.
18. Entrants will use their highest league average as of the end of the previous winter season, provided they have bowled 21 games or more. If no winter average has been established, an entrant may use a previous summer average, provided they have bowled 21 games or more. If neither has been established, an entrant shall use their highest league average for 21 games or more as of December 31, 2016. An entrant without a 21-game average as of December 31, 2016, shall be permitted to bowl, using their highest current league average, provided a minimum of 12 games have been bowled. All others must bowl scratch. When a bowler's current 21 game average as of December 31, 2016 is 10 pins higher than the previous season's average, the higher average must be used. See Rule 319a(2).
19. USBC tournament rules will prevail.
20. Open bowling will be permitted (not parties) provided one closed lane separate the tournament bowlers.
