# Allyn Hayes Southeast Alaska Masters Tournament Rules 2017

1. **Entering Average Specifications:**
  - a. Bowlers will use their highest average from the 2015-16 bowling season (Exceptions: See rules 1-b, c & e).
  - b. If bowler does not have a book average, they will use the highest 21+ game average as of 12/31/16.
  - c. If bowler has neither average described in a. or b. above, they may use highest 21 game average as of January 28<sup>th</sup>, 2017.
  - d. If a bowler's 12/31/16 "21+" game average is 10 or more pins higher than the 2015-16 book average, the 12/31/16 average must be used.
  - e. If a bowler does not have a league average, as described above, they may use last year's (2016) SE Master's 20+ game average. If a 20+ game SE Master's average is not available, they may use their 21+ game Tournament average with documents supporting their average. If the tournament was using a sport (blue) pattern, the bowler must add 30 pins to their sport average in the calculation. If the tournament was using a white pattern, 15 pins must be added. Note if no documentation for your tournament average is available, then the tournament director has discretionary option to use what he feels is fair, or scratch the bowler.
  - f. Any 21 game average, when being established from bowling more than 3 games per day, must be from a league with a minimum of 4 bowlers bowling on the team league at the same time. Less than 4 bowlers bowling on the team league when the league is in session is not allowed.
  - g. All other bowlers without an average as described above will bowl scratch.
  - h. Each bowler is responsible for verifying the accuracy of the reported average on the entry form. Failure to use the proper average or make a correction prior to completion of the first game of a series shall disqualify the score if the submitted average is lower than the actual average or base prize winnings on the submitted average if it is higher.
2. USBC re-rating rule 319e will apply to all bowlers, however due to geographical limits of this tournament, rule 319d will not apply.
3. This is a handicap tournament. The handicap will be based upon 85% of the difference between 230 and the qualified average.
4. This tournament is open to all bowlers who maintain a permanent residence in Alaska.
5. **All entrants are required** to show proof of USBC Membership and permanent residence. Non-members who show residence may purchase an affiliate membership card.
6. **The format of the Southeast Masters Tournament is outlined below:**
  - a. There will be 12 games of qualifying, bowled in two 6 game blocks.
  - b. The top 30 bowlers, based upon total pinfall plus handicap shall advance to semifinal match play. Pins will be carried forward from the 1<sup>st</sup> day to the 2<sup>nd</sup>.
  - c. Semifinal match play shall be 8 one game matches with 1<sup>st</sup> bowling 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> bowling 4<sup>th</sup>, etc. Thirty (30) bonus pins will be awarded for each match won and added to total pinfall. Standings will be recalculated after each match to determine next match.
  - d. Top 5 finishers after the semifinal matches shall advance to single elimination TV type format finals. Total pinfall is not carried forward into the finals after determining the top five finishers.
  - e. There will be a 10-minute warm-up at the start of the tournament bowlers bowling for the day.
7. Prize fund will be returned 100%. A prize ration of 1:4 or major fraction thereof shall be awarded.
8. Bowlers will not be allowed to bowl on the tournament lanes after said lanes have been dressed for tournament play.
9. Bowlers must check in at least 20 minutes prior to schedule bowling times.
10. Once the tournament has commenced, there will be no substitutions. If a bowler cannot complete the tournament, the bowler will scratch and entry fees will not be refunded.
11. Errors in scoring must be reported to the tournament directors prior to commencing bowling the next block or match.
12. All other USBC rules not addressed here are in effect.
