JUNEAU USBC YOUTH CITY CHAMPIONSHIP TOURNAMENT TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Entries close at 2:00 pm Saturday February 11th, 2016.
2. Only Juneau USBC members are eligible to participate.
3. The tournament is an open format. Teams and Doubles can be all boys, all girls, or mixed.
4. Handicap will be computed at 100% of the difference between the bowler's average and 200.
5. Entry fee is \$13.00 per event and \$3.00 for the optional all-events.
6. **All entrants are required** to show proof of USBC Membership. Non-members may purchase a membership card prior to bowling.
7. Entrants may, at their option, enter each event two (2) times:
 - a. An entrant may participate in any team event two (2) times. However, in no case shall a team with more than two (2) of the same bowlers be permitted to place more than once in the list for position standing.
 - b. An entrant may participate in any singles/doubles event two (2) times. However, in no case shall the same two (2) bowlers be permitted to place more than once in the list for position standings.
8. No entry money will be returned after being received by the Tournament Manager.
9. The team captain must verify check-in 30 minutes prior to squad times for team events and 15 minutes prior for singles/doubles.
10. A bowler may enter a team event without entering singles and doubles. A bowler may enter singles and doubles without entering a team event.
11. Anyone entering doubles must enter singles and vice-versa.
12. Team event will be bowled on one pair of lanes. Teams shall consist of four (4) bowlers.
13. Singles and doubles will be bowled jointly, moving lanes between events as directed by the tournament director. Singles will be bowled first. If the squad does not consist of 10 full lanes, the singles lanes will be assigned at the discretion of the tournament director. An entrant shall be permitted to bowl games in the doubles event without a doubles partner to qualify for the all-event championship.
14. An entrant who arrives late will forfeit shadow balls and will take "0" pins for each frame missed.
15. The trophy fund will be returned 100% based on the handicap scores on at least a 1 to 10 ratio.
16. The bowler's best appearance in each event shall count toward their "All Event" score.
17. All events will be figured on a handicap basis and awards will be based on at least a 1 in 10 ratio.
18. Rules 319c, 319d and 319e of the USBC Certified Tournament Rules do not apply.
19. Rule 322b applies regarding absentee scores.
20. Entrants will use their 2015-16 league average. If bowler does not have a 2015-16 league average, the bowler will use current average of 12 games as of February 11, 2017.
21. Open bowling will be permitted (not parties) provided one pair of closed lanes separate the tournament bowlers.
22. USBC rules and regulations govern the tournament.
